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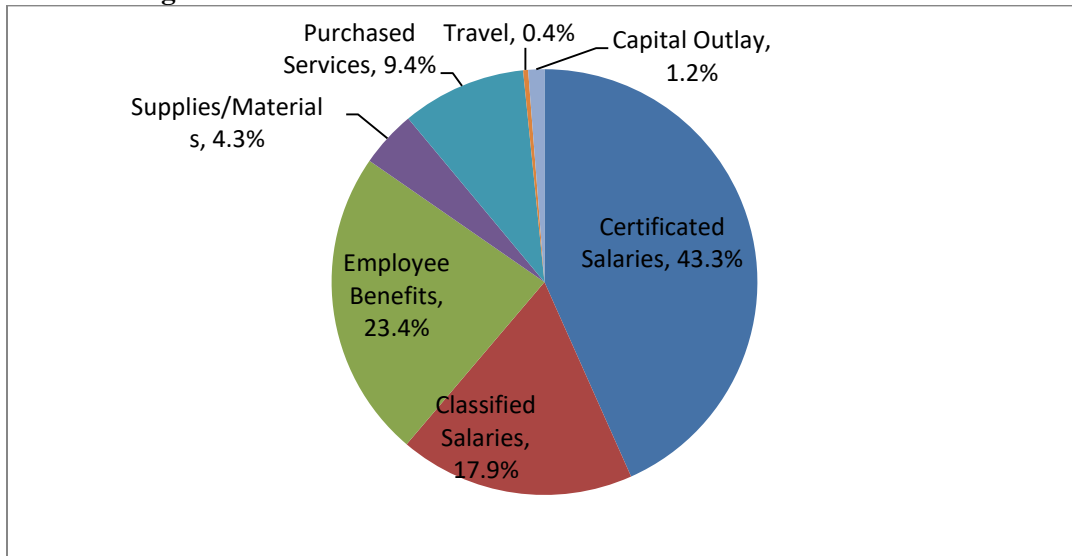
Student Growth Goals for HomeConnection

Teachers at Blaine HomeConnection will engage in student growth goal setting specific to the needs of their students and content areas. Additionally, HomeConnection staff will participate in learning and feedback relative to Criterion 3 and 8 of the Teacher Evaluation.

Invitation to Parents

Continual parental involvement is required of all families. K-8 parents enhance core academic subjects at home and supervise their children’s daily off-site learning activities. High School students enroll in a combination of on-site, off-site, and experiences with the option of earning credit toward a high school diploma and or college credit. Staff and parents work together to develop a year-long learning plan for each student. Progress on this plan is evaluated monthly by staff and parents.
